In-room amenities include DVD player, CD player and music library, satellite cable plasma T.V., automatic black out shades, hair dryers, safety deposit boxes, unobtrusive high-tech audiovisual equipment and lighting with dual bedside controls, and iPod docking stations. iPod minis are available for use upon request.

Esencia was transformed into an elegant estate for guests in 2005 by ProHotel International of Houston, which also operates the celebrated La Pleta Hotel and Spa in the Spanish Pyrenees and the Casanova Hotel in Barcelona, Spain. The 29-room, 50-acre Esencia, located on Playa Xpu-Ha on a two-mile stretch of fine white-sand beach 46 miles south of Cancun, is the essence of simplicity, elegance and beauty. Its 29 spacious suites and guestrooms include a range of features from private gardens to solariums and deep-soaking plunge pools.

Esencia's Aroma Spa, fully organic from its architecture to its products, harvests its own lush herb garden for indigenous fruits, plants and herbs to use in treatments such as a lemon ritual for energy, honey ritual for relaxation and chocolate ritual for stress-reduction. The 2,500 square foot palapa-roofed spa offers five treatment rooms, four Jacuzzis and two Mayan-style domed steam rooms. Guests dine at Sal y Fuego (Spanish for "salt and fire"), which features traditional Yucatecan methods such as banana-wrapped fish and meat cooked in a *pib* (an earth oven). The menu showcases the freshest local seafood as well as dishes from the rest of Mexico, all flavored with organic herbs and fresh fruits and vegetables.
